## **Association By-Laws and Conditions of Membership**

*As authorised by the Committee under the provisions of the Club's Constitution*

1. Whilst at the Clubs facility members and visitors must behave in a civil manner towards others. Abusive behaviour will not be tolerated under any circumstances. Members or visitors found to be behaving in such a way will be asked to leave the facility. Depending on the severity the Committee may take action towards the offending member/s or visitors to the extent of imposing bans from entering the Clubs facilities.
2. Membership fees will be split into two distinct periods and rates: 1 June to 30 November – 100% of prescribed annual fee, 1 December to 31 May 50% of prescribed annual fee.
3. Membership, unless renewed prior is considered expired from 1 June annually.
4. Facility access locks will be changed at the cessation of each membership year. It is a member responsibility to obtain a new access key upon renewal of their membership annually.
5. Access to the facility outside of scheduled Club race days is for members only. Members are not to pass on or loan their Club key to any other person. Members are to ensure that gate control measures are in place when attending the facility as outlined in the Club membership form.

Members may have non-members or visitors attend the facility outside of Club race days for the following purposes only.

- a. Assisting the member but not making use of the track.
- b. For the purpose of introducing/promoting non-racers to the sport of model car racing for which use of the track is allowed.
- c. Any other purpose but where the person / non-member does not benefit by having access to the track.

Members found to be promoting/organising or facilitating non-member use of the track other than for the purposes described above may face up to a 12-month suspension from the Club.

Members who have a disciplinary sanction imposed upon them will be required to return the facility access key(s) for the period of the imposed sanction and be subject to any other facility limitations/restrictions as may be imposed by any sanction.

6. The application of any treatment to the track surface is prohibited unless approved by the Club's Committee.
  - a. Any member or person found to have treated the track surface will face a minimum

12 month ban from entering the Club's facility or participating in Club activities.

**7. Attendance at the facility during Club or sanctioned race days.**

The facility has two distinct areas:

- a.** Track side – this is defined as being areas where competitors or their support crew need to be present and is broadly described as the pits, tire truing area, pit lane, the track and drivers stand etc.
- b.** Spectator areas (non-trackside) are defined as areas specifically allocated for visitors to view racing such as adjacent to and on the deck of the canteen.

Any person who wishes to enter 'track side' must be a member of an RCRA affiliated Club or and affiliated member of an RCRA club for the purpose of assisting a competitor during the event or be engaged by the Club as an official or person working for the Club.

All other persons will be asked to relocate to the spectator allocated areas.

**8. Parking of vehicles.**

- a.** Vehicles may be parked within the facility during Club race days subject to space being available. Overflow parking is available outside the facility within Helles Reserve.
- b.** During Club race days vehicles are not to be parked along the pit fence line except to allow for the loading or unloading at the start or conclusion of the event.
- c.** For sanctioned events, the Club will provide parking guidelines but principally parking will not be allowed within the facility except for Committee members and persons involved in the direct running of the event.
- d.** At all times liability for any damage to any vehicle shall be the sole responsibility of the vehicle's owner regardless of the circumstances under which the damage was incurred.

**9. Smoking.**

The Club is bound law to follow the requirements of Local Council and NSW Health regulations.

Smoking is not allowed whilst within the Clubs facility. Smoking outside of the Clubs facility may also be subject to restrictions. Any person found to be smoking with the Clubs facility will be asked to leave the facility whilst smoking.

Persons should inform themselves of any restrictions regarding smoking whilst within Helles Reserve.

The Club assumes no responsibility for any actions or fines imposed on any person in breach of these laws or regulations.
